NCCP Kairos #30 - August 5th - 8th

Dear Friends,

Almost fourteen years ago, the North Carolina Department of Prisons formally agreed to open the doors and allow Christian men of different denominations to bring Kairos Prison Ministry inside the walls of Central Prison. Led by the Holy Spirit, these men took the Word of God into Central Prison as the hands and feet of Jesus Christ. If you are not familiar with the Kairos Prison Ministry, Kairos is a three-day "Short Course in Christianity" similar in nature to the "Walk to Emmaus" "Cursillo," "Via de Christo," and some other three-day weekends. This event, defined as "God's Special Time," provides each resident attending the opportunity to experience God's special love that He has for each one of us.

On August 5th through the 8th I am called once again to be part of the team for Kairos #30 in Central Prison Raleigh, North Carolina and again taking the Good News of our Lord into a very dark place. We are expecting up to 42 residents to be in attendance. I am sending this letter asking you to consider supporting this ministry in two ways:

- First and most important, Kairos needs your prayers. I am asking you to consider praying for our team, the "outside" volunteers, the resident helpers, and the men attending Kairos #30.
- Second, I am asking you to please consider helping sponsor this event. Each inside volunteer is responsible for contributing a *minimum \$150 for himself* to offset the cost of sponsoring a resident for this event. As team members, we are encouraged not to pay this amount ourselves but to provide an opportunity for others to be a part of this great ministry. If you are so led, I am asking you to consider supporting this ministry with a small monetary contribution. If you wish to make a financial contribution to *Kairos*, please make checks payable to WFUMC and note *Kairos of NC,* and if you wish to contribute to the Kairos Cookie Fund we gladly accept home-baked cookies.
